AND VICTIMS' RIGHTS* SUMMER SCHOOL

PURPOSE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

The *Canadian Partnership for International Justice* is offering a \$ 2,000 scholarship to graduate students from developing countries¹ to attend the *International Justice and Victims' Rights* summer school². Under the direction of Jo-Anne Wemmers, Professor at the School of Criminology, the summer school will be held on May 31 to June 8, 2019 at the Montreal Centre for International Studies, University of Montreal (CÉRIUM). This scholarship will be used to help pay tuition, travel expenses, and stay of the student.

APPLICATION

Please create a file including:

- A short CV³, including the list of academic and professional achievements (e. g. education, scholarships, publications, presentations at conferences);
- A letter of motivation specifying their research interests and justifying the benefit of participating in the summer school for the advancement of their project;
- A copy of the grades obtained in their current program;
- A proof of current enrolment in a postsecondary institution.

Complete files must be emailed by **Friday, March 15, 2019** at 5:00 PM to valerie.meehan@umontreal.ca as a single file in PDF format. Only complete files will be taken into account.

¹ The school is bilingual (French-English). Students are expected to be fluent in French or English and to have at least a passive understanding of the other language.
