

GRANT FOR ASSISTANCE IN NETWORKING AND DEVELOPMENT

GOAL

A maximum of \$1,500 will be awarded annually to a member of the Centre who wishes to develop an international network of partners and new methodological skills by visiting a research centre outside Canada for a period of two to six weeks. Priority will be given to projects in the following geographical areas: South America, Africa and Asia.

The grant will facilitate travel in order to increase ties with a team of researchers and allow exploration of opportunities for collaboration in the field, as well as encouraging observation of the ways in which research projects are being implemented and exploration of the feasibility of such projects in Quebec. It also provides the opportunity to become familiar with methodologies and analytical tools through contact with their designers. This financial assistance can support internal funding of an institution (university, college, etc.).

REQUIREMENTS

- Be a CICC's regular researcher;
- A brief summary of the project, including the location of the centre to be visited and a description of the activity to be undertaken;
- A project budget and schedule;
- A report on the completed visit.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

The grant will be awarded on the basis of the excellence of the project, its compatibility with the CICC's research program, and the financial needs of the applicant.

- Grants will be awarded on a first come, first served basis, based on the availability of annual funds for the support of CICC's regular researchers.
