## 3 scholarships of \$2,000 each

TO ATTEND BILINGUAL SUMMER SCHOOL

INTERNATIONAL JUSTICE AND VICTIMS' RIGHTS

Montreal, June 1 to 6, 2020

### Purpose of the scholarship

To encourage students from universities affiliated with the <u>Canadian Partnership for International Justice</u> to attend\* the bilingual summer school on "*International Justice and Victims' Rights*". This scholarship will assist with the registration and travel costs of three recipients.

#### To be eligible

- 1. Be registered as a full-time graduate student;
- 2. Study at a university affiliated with the Partnership OR be supervised by a member of the Partnership;
- 3. Have completed and validated the registration for the "International Justice and Victims' Rights" summer school.

#### **Evaluation criteria**

The application must include the following:

- A letter of motivation addressing the importance of the scholarship for the student's participation in the summer school (maximum 500 words);
- A copy of their transcript for the current university program;
- A short <u>standardized curriculum vitae</u>, according to the model used by the scholarship committee of the *International Center for Comparative Criminology* (ICCC).

#### Presentation of the application

- The application must be submitted no later than Wednesday April 1, 2020, 4:00 p.m.
- Completed applications must be sent by e-mail in a single PDF file to <a href="mailto:ismehen.melouka@umontreal.ca">ismehen.melouka@umontreal.ca</a> (You can also send any questions to this address).

\*Given the Université de Montréal's interuniversity agreements with other Canadian universities, only students from Quebec universities will be able to receive <u>credits</u> for their participation in the course. Students from other Canadian universities can, however, register as observers.
