TO ATTEND BILINGUAL SUMMER SCHOOL

INTERNATIONAL JUSTICE AND VICTIMS' RIGHTS

Montreal, June 1 to 6, 2020

Purpose of the scholarship

To encourage students from universities affiliated with the [Canadian Partnership for International Justice](#) to attend* the bilingual summer school on "*International Justice and Victims' Rights*". This scholarship will assist with the registration and travel costs of three recipients.

To be eligible

1. Be registered as a full-time graduate student;
2. Study at a university affiliated with the Partnership OR be supervised by a member of the Partnership;
3. Have completed and validated the registration for the "*International Justice and Victims' Rights*" summer school.

Evaluation criteria

The application must include the following:

- A letter of motivation addressing the importance of the scholarship for the student's participation in the summer school (maximum 500 words);
- A copy of their transcript for the current university program;
- A short [standardized curriculum vitae](#), according to the model used by the scholarship committee of the *International Center for Comparative Criminology* (ICCC).

Presentation of the application

- The application must be submitted no later than Wednesday April 1, 2020, 4:00 p.m.
- Completed applications must be sent by e-mail in a single PDF file to ismehen.melouka@umontreal.ca (You can also send any questions to this address).

**Given the Université de Montréal's interuniversity agreements with other Canadian universities, only students from Quebec universities will be able to receive credits for their participation in the course. Students from other Canadian universities can, however, register as observers.*
