



VISITING RESEARCHER STUDENT PROGRAM

PROGRAM OBJECTIVE

The International Centre for Comparative Criminology offers students enrolled in criminology or related disciplines (master or doctoral level), the opportunity to join the Centre (preferably between September and June). This is a unique opportunity to work on a research project in collaboration with a CICC researcher.

Successful applicants will have access to an office, Internet, Library and administrative support from the Centre.

COMMITMENT AND CONDITIONS

- An application must be filed to the Graduates Studies Faculty (<u>FESP</u>) (if visiting research stay at Université de Montréal)
- For a period of 120 days or more, a work permit is required, if applicable, for non-residents of Canada. The CICC will pay a part of the work permit's costs and it is the responsibility of the visiting researcher student to get a visa, if applicable. Other documents may therefore be required to complete the application.
- The successful applicant agrees to participate in scientific activities organized by the CICC (conferences, workshops, etc.);
- The Centre will NOT pay any wages, travel or living expenses, or assume the costs related to the research project of the candidate.

SELECTION

- **Y** The jury is composed of the director, assistant director and a regular researcher with the CICC;
- The length of stay may vary depending on the file submitted and the nature of the research, as well as places available;

APPLICATION

Applications must include:

- A curriculum vitae;
- A cover letter (two to three pages) specifying the requested dates of stay and outlining the project to be conducted at the CICC;
- A **letter of invitation** from a regular researcher of our Centre with a brief summary of the reason for the invitation including details of the project or the work to be undertaken.
